Parking

Follow directional signage once you turn into Three Springs. Shuttle buses will transport attendee's to the venue front gate (approximately 1/2 mile north of the Three Springs development). \$5 donation per car requested. Please carpool!!

Transportation

Durango Transit

FREE all day on whole system thanks to Alpine Bank! Can pick up anywhere on the system and transfer at the Durango Transit center downtown to go to Three Springs. You can also pick up the Transit at the Mercury Payment Systems stop, which will run every 30 minutes (approximately 15 minutes after and 15 minutes before the top of the hour). Please park on the street, NOT in the Mercury parking lot. Durango Transit will run special service from the Mercury stop starting at 12:45pm and ending at 8pm.

What's allowed in the show?

Low-back chairs, coolers, water, food, cameras. Shade structures are allowed but if they impede the view of others, please set up along the perimeter of the venue. We highly recommend festival style set-up: a tarp and blanket, as the ground is covered with wood chips.

What's not allowed in the show?

Alcohol, glass, firearms, pets, smoking of any kind.

Day-of

• \$45. Available at the gate.

VIP

• \$100. Available in advance or at the door. Includes beer, wine, non-alcoholic beverages, appetizers between 2-5pm, stage-side covered seating.
